All students must come to school wearing:

- a Gladesmore branded navy blue jumper
- their year group tie
  - Year 7 blue, Year 8 green, Year 9 gold
  - Year 10 purple, Year 11 red
- a plain light blue shirt
- plain navy trousers or skirt
- plain navy blue or black socks or tights
- plain black leather/simulated leather shoes with black soles, laces, straps etc. No trainers/canvas style footwear allowed.

Hair colouring should be natural.

Acrylic finger nails and artificial eye-lashes are not allowed.

Caps and hats are not to be worn in school.

Do-rags, bandanas and bonnets are not allowed.

Piercings – only stud earrings are allowed.

PE kit should only be worn during PE lessons.
