Dear Parents/Carers,

At Gladesmore, we take great pride in the high standards our students demonstrate every day at school. Our REACH values—Respect, Enthusiasm, Aspiration, Cooperation, and Hard Work—underpin everything we do, and we expect our students to reflect these values in how they present themselves at school.

We would like to remind all parents and carers of our uniform expectations. In particular, we would draw your attention to the following:

- **Hooded tops** – These are not permitted in school and will be confiscated if worn.
- **Trainers** – Only formal black school shoes are allowed; trainers are not part of the uniform.
- **Non-religious head coverings** – These are not permitted in school and will be confiscated if worn.
- **Short skirts** – Skirts must be an appropriate length, ensuring modesty at all times.
- **Sagging trousers** – Trousers should be worn at the waist, not low on the hips.
- **False eyelashes & facial piercings** – Visible facial piercings and false eyelashes are not allowed and must be removed during school hours. These are not appropriate for school and should not be worn.
- **Hair colour** – Only natural hair colours are permitted.

Students who do not adhere to our [uniform policy](#) will be asked to correct their appearance. If this is not possible, they may be sent home to change. Repeated failure to follow uniform expectations will result in further sanctions.
