Re: National Education Union (NEU) Strike Action Update

I am writing to provide an update regarding the ongoing strike action by the National Education Union (NEU). Strike action has now been confirmed for Tuesday 11th, Wednesday 12th and Thursday 13th. Due to the impact of the strike, the school will not be able to operate safely for all students. However, the following arrangements will be in place:

Students with Special Educational Needs and/or Disabilities (SEND):

The school will remain open for students with SEND who wish to attend. These students will be supervised while accessing online learning.

Year 11 Students:

Students in Year 11 must come to school to continue with taught lessons. The school day for SEND and Year 11 students will follow this schedule:

- **Arrival:** 9:00 am (Crowland Road gate)
- **Lunch:** 12:30 pm - 1:30 pm
- **Departure:** 12:30 pm (Crowland Road gate)

Year 9 Vaccinations:

Year 9 meningitis vaccinations will go ahead as planned for students whose parents have completed a consent form. Students should arrive at the school sports centre at 8:45 AM.

Free School Meals:

Students entitled to free school meals will be provided with lunch. These students should arrive at the Crowland Road entrance by 12:30 pm. A packed lunch will be available for them to either eat at school or take home.

We strongly encourage all students to continue their learning remotely by accessing the available resources on Google Classroom.
