I am writing to let you know that your GCSE and BTec results will be available to collect on **Thursday 12th August from 10:00am to 12:00pm.**

We are really looking forward to Results Day and welcoming you back. The grades achieved will be the result of your hard work and dedication in very difficult circumstances. I would like take this opportunity to reiterate that your results will be 'real grades' and will be treated as such by colleges, sixth forms, universities and employers going forward. I hope that you will be proud of your results following all of your efforts.

The School determined the Centre Assessed Grades by looking at the evidence of your performance such as in examinations, assessments and coursework tasks. These were assessed by groups of subject teachers working together, the marking was cross checked with external moderators involved to appraise the marks and support the process.
