Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Start of Term Arrangements

I hope you are well and are enjoying the summer break.

I am writing to update you on the situation following the heavy rainfall earlier this month which caused severe flooding in parts of the school site. This led to extensive damage to ceilings, lighting, and to the electrical power supply to parts of the Main building.

This has required the electric supply to several blocks to be turned off whilst the electrical contractors check, repair and restore service. Remedial works are likely to take several more days to ensure power can be restored as quickly and safely as possible. We have been advised that during the time that this remedial work is taking place, staff and students should not be on site. Unfortunately, we estimate a week's delay to the start of school for students.

The revised return to school dates are as follows:

- Year 11 – Friday 9th September @ 9:00am (Crowland Road Entrance)
