Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: National Education Union (NEU) planned strike action on 27th April and 2nd May.

I am writing to provide further updates on NEU planned strike action.

The NEU announced that there will be two days of strike action on Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May. The impact on the normal day to day running of the school will not allow the safe opening of the school to all students.

As with previous strike action, school will be open to all students with Special Educational Needs and/or Disabilities (SEND) should they wish to attend. Students will be supervised whilst they access work online. The outline of the school day for students is as follows:

- Arrival: 8.50am, Gladesmore Road gate
- Venue: CLC block for lessons
- Departure: 12.20pm, Gladesmore Road gate
- Lunch: 12.20 – 1.00pm

In addition to this provision, all year 11 students will be expected to attend school in preparation for their GCSE/BTEC examinations as follows:

- Arrival: 8.50am, Gladesmore Road gate
- Lunch: 12.20 -1.00pm
- Departure: 2.00pm

In relation to strike days, the Department for Education has designated that we code student absence with a 'Y' code which does not count as a student school absence.

We will also provide lunch for students who are entitled to a free school meal. These students should arrive at the Gladesmore Road entrance by 12.20pm with their dinner cards. A packed lunch will be provided for students to either eat at school or take home. Please note that students that arrive for school meals will not be accommodated at school after the lunch period.

I understand that this disruption to your child's education may be frustrating so I will keep you informed on developments on the future planned strike days as soon as possible.
